# **Renaissance Oasis Birch**



**The most drought-tolerant birch in the Renaissance Series. The juvenile bark is an outstanding red-bronze, turning white with attractive exfoliation. Dense, broad pyramidal form. Dark green leaves turn yellow in fall. Height: 50-60' Spread: 30-40**



# **Ivory Silk Japanese Tree Lilac**



**These are a most attractive, small flowering tree with cherry-like bark; They bear large creamy white flower clusters in early July. And will perform best in full sun. Compact and oval shaped, these can grow to 25' and spread to 15'.**



# American Linden



**This rapid growing tree has fragrant yellow flowers and large, dense foliage that provides excellent shade. Although it will grow in dry heavier soils, it prefers deep moist soils.**

**Height; 75-90' Spread: 40-50'**



# **Boulevard Linden**



**The Boulevard Linden grow to 60' with a spread of 30'. This is planted for its narrow, pyramidal habitat and ascending branches. A perfect tree for boulevards or other places where the width is restricted. A perfect replacement for the Ash tree. Fragrant yellow flowers are produced in mid to late June.**



# Frontyard Linden



**The Frontyard Linden is selected for its excellent symmetrical branching habit. A great “front yard” tree, it is broadly pyramidal when it is young and nicely rounded with age. The dense foliage offers excellent shade. Height: 50-75' Spread: 40'**



# Autumn Blaze Maple



**This hybrid of the silver and red maple has become extremely popular due to its rapid growth rate, ascending branch habit, and drought tolerance when established. The Autumn Blaze Maple has beautiful fall color and form.**

**Height: 50-60' Spread: 40'**



# Fall Fiesta Sugar Maple



**Fall Fiesta Sugar Maple is has branching that is full and symmetrical. Leathery, glossy, deep green leaves are resistant to leaf tatter and leafhopper damage. A rapid grower, easy to transplant and also resistant to sun scald and frost cracks. Outstanding fall color, shows far more oranges and reds than other sugar maples. Prefers a moist yet well-drained soil. Height: 50-75' Spread: 50'**



# Sienna Glen Maple



**This is a fast growing, hardy maple with uniform branching and a pyramidal form.**

**Superior to Autumn Blaze® maple in withstanding strong winds. Is considered a very good substitute for ash varieties. Beautiful fall colors! Turns yellow, orange and red in the fall. Height: 60' Spread: 40'**



# Northern Red Oak



**The Northern Red Oak is the fastest growing oak and one of the easiest to transplant, this tree is great for street use or as a landscape tree. The foliage is dense and lustrous and leaves hang on the tree into winter.**

**Height: 60-80' Spread: 50'**



# Niobe Weeping Willow



**This fast growing golden barked willow has a wide spreading canopy and long, drooping branches. Height: 50' Spread: 50'.**
