

Garden Perennials



Bleeding Heart Early spring it bursts from the ground. Presents outstanding arching sprays of large, puffy, heart-shaped flowers. Plant in shade or part sun. Grows 30"-36" tall.



Catmint, Purrsian Blue
Rugged, easy to grow. Thrives in harsh conditions. Forms a dense, mounded clump of green, aromatic foliage. Periwinkle blue flowers. Grows 14"-18" tall.



Coneflower, Cheyenne Spirit
The first of its kind offering a color range from tomato red, magenta, near fluorescent orange, yellow-gold and white. Grows 22"-30"



Daylily, Buttered Popcorn
Large flowers, very fragrant. Many blooms per stem. Grows 32" tall.



Daylily, Chicago Apache
Scarlet red petals with a yellow to green throat. Blooms in late July to early August. 5" bloom, 15" flower spike, 12" plant



Daylily, Christmas Ribbon
Easy to spot this beauty from a distance with its gigantic, star-shaped Christmas red,, sunfast blossoms that are 8"-9" across. Grows 34" tall.



Daylily, Exotic Candy
Highly fragrant light pink flowers with a dark rose eye and bright green centers. Blooms midsummer and again later in the season. Ruffled rounded petals back to reveal center. 4" blooms, 12" flower spike, 10" plant.




Daylily, Frans Hals
Bicolor flowers with orange and bright reddish copper petals with creamy orange midribs. 6 pointed star forms. Grows to 24"



Daylily, Funny Valentine
Noted for its large non fading rose red blossoms which remain attractive all season long. Flowers have ruffled edges. Produces up to 25 blooms per stem. Grows 28"



Daylily, Hyperion
Lemon yellow blossoms with a tiny green throat. Trumpet flower form. Shape of a lily. Sweetly fragrant. Grows to 20"



Daylily, Ice Carnival
Large, fragrant, reblooming daylily that shimmers in the sun. Near-white petals with a pale yellow watermark and lime green throat.



Daylily, Marque Moon
One of the best! Extravagantly ruffled, fragrant, fancy sparkling, cream colored blossoms with a radiating yellow throat and matching wavy edge. Grows 24".



Daylily, My Melinda
Rosy pink petals with pale pink mid-ribs and a small yellow band in the center, petals slightly recurved.



Daylily, Pink Abundance
Diamond dusted rose pink flowers. Many flowers on each plant. Extended bloomer. Multiplies quickly.



Daylily, Pizza Crust
With an edge like a bubbly stuffed pizza, these flowers are a unique blend of pale peach, rose and cream with a yellow glow in the center. Grows 30" tall.



Daylily, Raspberry Suede
Velvety textured flowers. Huge 5" blooms in mid-season. Fast grower.

Garden Perennials



Daylily, Spellbinder
Show Stopper. Longest blooming daylilies. Large, radiant golden orange flowers. Pest resistant foliage.



Daylily, Stella de Oro
Most popular. Easy to grow. Abundant golden yellow flowers are the first to appear in early summer. Reblooms until early fall. Grows to 18".



Daylily, Tawny
Gransma's favorite!
Produces huge quantities of orange flowers which bloom for up to 1 1/2 month in midsummer. Spreads slowly



Daylily, Yellow
Reliable producer of huge yellow flowers which contrast nicely with dark green foliage. Very fragrant. (largest bloom)



Delphinium, Blue Butterfly
Hardy border plant. Noted for its multiple blossoms. Clouds of rich blue flowers. Grows 12"-18"



Flax, Apar
Produces beautiful sky-blue flowers in early summer. Hardy perennial resists drought and winter cold. Grows 1'=2'



Gaillardia, Arizona Sun
Spreading wildflower with daisy-like flowers provide a continuous display of large, single, mahogany-red flowers with bright yellow petal edges on compact plants. Grows 8"-10"



Gas Plant, Pink
Bear wands of cupped pink or white flowers. One of the showiest plants in the garden. Grows 1'-3'.



Hosta, Blueberry Muffin
Corrugated blue heart shaped leaves with red speckled petioles. Lavender flowers early summer. Grows 14" tall.



Hosta, Frances Williams
Giant, blue-green leaves with yellow margins. Slug resistant leaves are thick and corrugate. White flowers. Grows 22".



Hosta, Golden Tiara
Small hosta with golden thin heart shaped leaves. Grows rapidly. Grows 6" - 1'.



Hosta, Great Expectations
One of the best. Bold blue-green leaf margins with creamy yellow heart. Grows to 22"



Hosta, Guacamole
Forms large, dense clumps and thrives in partial shade, where the sun can brighten the leaf centers. Three foot tall flower spikes.



Hosta, Humberk Whale
Forms a massive, dome-shaped mound of blue-green, corrugated, heart shaped leaves. Blue color is most intense in the spring. Strong flower stalks support white bell shaped flowers. Grows 36"



Hosta, June
Gold and blue green leaves. Likes moist soils. Leaves up to 22".



Hosta, Northern Exposure
Huge 13" leaves are broad and deeply textured in frosty blue with creamy artistic edging. White flowers.

Garden Perennials



Iris, Siberian 'Caesars Brother'

Old standby variety produces beautiful violet blue flowers which contrast nicely with dark green leaves. Good landscape plant.



Iris, Siberian 'Dance and Sing'

Displays yellow buds which open to beautiful 3.5" flowers. Upright petals are creamy yellow and falls are light yellow



Pasque Flower 'Hybrid'

Hybrid. Similar to the native pasque flower but produces a larger more deep purple bloom.



Rhubarb, Victoria

The rhubarb grandma grew! Great for pies, sauce, and jam. Freezes well. Produces long, thick stalks which are reddish at base. Very productive.



Sage, Russian

Extremely fine and delicate textured foliage emerges silver in the spring and gradually turns green throughout summer. Grows 3'



Salvia, Deep Rose Sensation

Forms a robust, compact clump of textured, rugose, green foliage. Flowers heavily with bright pink flower stalks on purple stems. Full sun. Grows 16"



Salvia, May Night

Dense spikes of deep violet-purple flowers. Blooms over a long period and can be extended by deadheading. Attracts bees and butterflies!!



Sedum, Autumn Joy

Spectacular autumn display of large rosy-salmon flowers. Attracts butterflies and pollinators. Easy to grow and drought tolerant. Grows 2'.



Sedum, Frosted Fire

Flower is red and bloom's in fall and summer. Best in sun. Average to dry soils.



Sedum, Neon

Bright rosy, magenta bloomis over light green foliage forming a somewhat compact , upright clump.
